#### **SWEET POTATO HOTDISH**

#### **Ingredients:**

- 3.5 lbs. sweet potatoes, peeled and cut into 1-inch chunks
- 1/3 cup honev
- 1 large egg
- 1 tsp. ground cinnamon
- 1/4 tsp. salt
- 1 Tbsp. packed dark brown sugar
- 1/3 cup finely chopped pecans

**Directions:** Preheat the oven to 350 degrees. Mist an 8-inch square baking dish with cooking spray. Bring water to a boil and cook sweet potatoes until tender (about 20 - 25 minutes). Transfer the potatoes to a bowl and let cool. Add honey, egg, 1/2 tsp. cinnamon, nutmeg, ginger and 1/4 tsp. salt. Whip with an electric mixer until smooth. Spread sweet potato mixture in baking dish. Mix brown sugar, pecans and remaining cinnamon in a bowl; sprinkle over potatoes. Bake until hot and edges start to brown (40 - 45 minutes).
