## NEED HELP WITH YOUR UTILITY BILLS? ENERGY ASSISTANCE IS AVAILABLE

BENCO wants to help our members find energy assistance resources to help bring their account current. Minnesota's Energy Assistance Program (EAP) increased the amount of funding available to help members pay costs associated with heat and electricity. Funding is available on a first-come, first-served basis, so it is crucial to contact an energy assistance agency as soon as possible.

EAP helps eligible households maintain affordable, continuous and safe home energy. Services include bill payment assistance, home energy crisis intervention, outreach, energy advocacy, information about utility consumer rights and referrals.

Individuals must occupy the residence for which the energy assistance benefits are being applied and meet the household income guidelines.

## **BREAKFAST PIZZA**

#### **Ingredients:**

- 1 lb. pork sausage 1 pkg. crescent rolls
- 5 eggs
- 1/4 C milk
- 1/2 tsp. salt
- 1/8 tsp. pepper
- 1 C frozen hash brown potatoes
- 1 C shredded cheddar cheese
- · 2 Tbsp. grated parmesan cheese

#### **Directions:**

Cook sausage and drain excess fat. Separate crescent roll dough into eight triangles and

place into ungreased 12 in. pizza pan with points toward center. Press over bottom and up the sides to form a crust. Seal perforations. Spoon sausage over crust and sprinkle with potatoes. Top with cheddar cheese. In a small bowl, beat eggs, milk, salt and pepper. Pour over crust. Sprinkle with parmesan cheese over all. Bake at 350 degrees for 25 - 30 minutes.
